Therefore, contests in ranning, jumping, discusand javelin throwing boxing and horse and chariot racing were held in individual cities and the winners competed every four years at mount Olympus. Winners were greatly honoused by having poems sung about their deeds. Originally these were held as games of friendship, and any wars in the progess were halted to allow the games to take place. The Greeks attached so much importance to these games that they calculated time in four-year cycles called 'Olympiads' dating from 776 BC.
